- **AIM: Advanced Illness Management**, a palliative medicine consultative service, provides an extra layer of support for anyone living with a serious illness.
- **Ashewood Grief and Counseling Services** provides grief support services to patients, families, and the community.

With more than 200 patients a day, our hospice serves North Carolina residents of Caldwell, Alexander, Ashe, Avery, Burke, Catawba, Watauga, and Wilkes counties.
