ADDITIONAL SERVICES

HOPE HOME HEALTH is available to non-hospice patients who are recovering from surgery or living with a chronic ailment such as cancer. Skilled professionals provide pain interventions and other nursing care in the comfort of the patient's own home.

ADVANCED ILLNESS CARE is a free program to keep patients connected to Hope until they meet the Medicare requirements for hospice. Hope staff can help make an easy transition to hospice or home health care when the time is right.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION

Hope Hospice provides a year-round **Family Caregiver Education Series** at no cost. Topics include how to advocate for your loved one in the complex healthcare system and meal planning for the chronically ill.

Our expanding **Living With Dementia** program offers free workshops that focus on concerns of caring for a loved one with cognitive decline.

Hope's Outreach Team and clinicians regularly host **free presentations** about nutrition, diabetes, dementia, and other topics at local senior living communities.
